The other day, our garage door opener stopped working. The light worked but the door did not open. The remote didn't open the door. The button by the stairs didn't open the door. Nothing opened the door. It needed to be replaced. So, we bought a new one and I set out to replace our garage door opener.

The directions said it could be done by one person in four hours. I can do that. I started to take down the old one. At one point, I was up on the ladder looking at how the old opener was wired to the button and the sensors. Levi came out and asked if he could take a look. Within minutes he had everything unhooked and the opener was now lying on the floor. "That's great!" I said, "How do I know how to hook up the new opener?"

"Red to red, white to white, and the one with the black tape goes to the button." Levi did, in a manner of minutes, what would have taken me a lot longer. I'm glad he helped me out.

A bit later, when it came time to hang the new opener, I realized there was no way I could lift it up, put the ladder under it to hold it up, and bolt it in place all by myself. That part in the directions that said it could be done by one person did not consider that I only had two hands. I needed help. Fortunately, Gina was able to come out and help me with that step in the process.

I (we) did get the opener hung and it is functioning like it should, but I could not have done it all by myself, regardless of what the directions said.

We were not created to live life by ourselves. God created Adam and Adam said he needed a companion. Jesus sent out the disciples in pairs. Paul always had a travelling companion. From the very first people to populate the world, relationships mattered.

When you think about it, relationship building is the purpose of the Church. We are called not only to strengthen our own relationship with Christ, but to walk with others in their relationship with Christ, whether that be a new relationship or a life -long relationship.

Think about it this way: your relationship with Christ is like the vertical beam of the cross – reaching from the heavens down to you; your relationship with others is like the horizontal beam of the cross – reaching out to your friends and loved ones, your neighbors, and even your enemies. This is the work of the Church viewed through the work of the Cross. This is what we were created for.

This fall we're rolling out a number of new relationship builders. We're adding a few new small groups – a prayer study and a grief support group, and others are in the works for later in the year. There will be a new youth group for 5th and 6th graders. WAM is expanding. Popovers/Dinner Groups will be tweaked just a little. The Chosen groups will start back up soon. Fantasy Football, Faith, & Fellowship will be kicking off its second season. And, of course, there are so many more relationship builders for you to check out – choir and bell choir, women's groups and the Saturday morning men's Bible study, Confirmation partners and Mobile Banquet helpers. The list goes on and on.

This month's newsletter is a little bigger than usual because of all the stuff happening.

And all that stuff is happening because relationships matter.

The Preschool classes will start back on Thursday, August 14th. Our teachers are looking forward to another successful school year!





The ELC has not had as profitable year and will end the year will a loss. July 21st the roofing and skylight replacement project should begin. We were fortunate to earn some extra income on the insurance check to help offset the expenses. The next fiscal year starts 9/1 so we are working on budgets for the next fiscal year and the annual meeting. Mark your calendars for September 28th!
