

Do you remember the story of Elijah on Mt Carmel? After years of drought, Elijah challenges a few hundred false-god-worshipping priests to see whose god is the real god. The other priests build an altar, throw their sacrificial bull on the altar, and call on their god to burn up the bull. Nothing happens. They pray harder. Nothing happens. Elijah makes fun of them so they try even harder. Still, nothing happens.

Elijah builds an altar, throws his bull on the altar, and soaks the whole thing with a boatload of water. Elijah prays to God to burn up his bull. Fire falls from the sky and burns everything up, including the rocks. Elijah wins. (technically, God wins) Elijah expects all the witnesses to convert to worshipping the one true God, but instead, the queen vows to kill Elijah within the next day.<sup>1</sup>

Do you remember the story of Jonah? God wanted him to deliver a message of repentance to the people of Nineveh. Instead, Jonah ran the other way because he didn't want to go to Nineveh because he didn't like those people. Jonah gets thrown off a ship, swallowed by a great fish, and spit out near Nineveh. Jonah concedes to God, goes to Nineveh and delivers the message. The people repent. God shows them mercy, and Jonah throws a tantrum of Biblical proportions because he doesn't want the Ninevites to be saved.<sup>2</sup>

Do you remember the story of Peter walking on water? The disciples are in their boat heading to the other side of the lake. A huge storm builds up and threatens the safety of the disciples. They see a ghost walking on top of the water. Wait, not a ghost, Jesus. Peter got excited because Jesus invited him to walk on the water also. But Peter got more than the bottom of his sandals wet as he began to sink.<sup>3</sup>

Do you see a pattern starting to form? Things are looking good. We do what God asks of us. Even the hard stuff. We feel good about everything.

But...the queen still wants you dead, God gives mercy to those you don't like, you still have moments of doubt.

Do you remember the story of Jesus? One day he's the grand marshal of an impromptu parade. A few days later his friends betray him, his people turn against him, and he is whipped and hung on a cross to die.<sup>4</sup>

But that wasn't the end of Jesus' story. Nope. There was more. That's when the good stuff happened – the really good stuff. The tomb was empty and Jesus was alive!

These Bible stories aren't just Sunday School lessons. These stories give us the truth about life and about God. Most of us have had our spirits crushed when we thought we should be in the highest of highs. Maybe it's unexpected changes at work, family feuds, or a health scare. The truth about life is that sometimes nothing goes right.

In the above stories (and most Bible stories), the bad, sad, depressing, angry, scary parts is when we see God show up. It's not that God was absent in the beginning of the stories, it's just that we're too busy in our struggles to see God. When we quit struggling within ourselves, we can start to see God in the periphery. God starts to get our attention. Sure, we might argue with him or doubt him but we still see him. It might take a minute realize what's all going on, but the truth about God is that he doesn't abandon us.

He didn't abandon his son on the cross or in the tomb. And he doesn't abandon us, who are also his daughters and sons, when our lives are at their darkest.

Do you remember the story when God gave up on you? It never happened. God doesn't give up on you. And that's the truth about God.

Pledged giving was slightly under budget for February. Expenses were also under budgeted for the month. February ended with a positive bottom line and a strong YTD balance that is ahead of budget (although this has been another year of increased maintenance and repair expenses). This would indicate FLC should end the fiscal year August 31st with a positive bottom line vs the budgeted deficit. What a blessing! We continue to work through the project list with donors including new conference tables, new library furniture and an additional van for the upcoming youth trip to name a few. Lawn care, phone/internet contracts and soon P&L insurance contracts have been reviewed to ensure the best and most affordable options are in place. ELC remains in a deficit YTD with rate increases going in effect in March. Anticipate ELC will break even to a slight deficit for their fiscal year ending 8/31. Happy Easter - He is risen indeed!
